

# STONE TOWN TOUR Wold Heritage Site

Stone Town is the cultural heart of the island and the old city area of City, located Zanzibar on the western shore. The city got its name from the many big multistory buildings made of stone which form the landscape of the old town part. This buildings are actually not made of stone, but with mortar and corals. Although the corals were a good and easily available building material, they are also easily damageable.


Some of the houses are in a bad shape and the Stone Town Conservation Authority coordinates the restorations of this houses to maintain the towns original glory.

The city still retained its old style from the 19th century, when Zanzibar was an important trading center in the Indian Ocean. It is a town of large bazaars, mosques, winding and narrow alleys, and large Arab houses, with two cathedrals and over 50 mosques.


# PRISON ISLAND TRIP 7 Home of giant Tortoise

Prison Island, also known as Changuu island or Quarantine island, located in the Zanzibar Archipelago.

In 1893 the former British prime minister of Zanzibar purchased the island and built a prison complex on it. But - it never served to its intended use! It was used as a quarantine station for yellow fever cases.

Today is the building a ruin, but it serves as a lovely guesthouse for tourists, where you'll be able to relax a bit and enjoy magnificent views after visiting the giant tortoises' reserve, where you will admire, pet, and even feed these magnificent, ancient, peaceful creatures. But - they are not locals! Four specimens of Aldabra giant tortoises were a gift from the governor of Seychelles in 1919.

They found Prison Island a great environment and bred freely. Today, many tortoises are welcoming you, and the first settlers are still among them!





Jozani forest is Zanzibar's only national park, and although quite small, 50 square km only, it's bursting with life in all its forms.


JOZANI FOREST The Hidden Jungle

Jozani forest is also a natural pharmacy, an amazing source of natural remedies! Every tree or plant cures something. Your experienced guide will lead you through the network of paths and give you some surprising information on the plant's use. The path will lead you through the mangrove habitat, A trip to Jozani forest will recharge your batteries to proceed to another adventure.

### NAKUPENDA BEACH Dimit Day Out rip



### MNEMBAISLAND Swim with Dolphing

Your private guide with a private boat will take you on a half day trip to Matemwe beach at Mnemba island (often wrongly referred to as an atoll), a jewel sitting in the sea. Its vast coral reef, measuring several kilometers in diameter, listed as a marine reserve, is the most popular snorkeling spot in Zanzibar.

Besides the fish and corals, look out for blue starfish, Red-knobbed starfish, or the fearsome crown-ofthorns starfish, a poisonous, coraleating species.

While exploring the reef, you have a great chance to meet a dolphin at a very close range, they like the waters of the reef and often swim with divers. If the time is right, you may even see the green turtles heading to lay their eggs at the beach.

After this exceptional snorkeling experience, you'll be taken to a nearby sandbank for a relaxed delicious seafood lunch.






# MTENDE BEACH Beauty, Fun & Relaxation
